## **Guidelines for Presentation - Information Sheet**

Also refer to the Charity Nomination Form

Presentations should be simple, not too formal but contain detailed information about the charity you are nominating. You are making a pitch to members for their support. Your objective is to secure the most votes for your charity...the result being up to \$10,000 for this valuable cause.

These presentations are made by members\* of 100 Women Who Care Oxford.

Topics to be covered:

1. Name of the charity
2. Where does the charity operate?
3. Mission statement of the charity?
4. What is the objective of the charity - answer the questions of who do they serve, what do they do, how do they support their clients
5. How significant would this donation be to this charity?
6. How would the funds be spent? Be as specific as possible. NOTE:  
**These funds MUST remain in Oxford County**
7. What other sources of funding does this charity have? E.g. Federal, Provincial, Municipal, independent fundraising, etc.
8. Will the charity issue income tax receipts?
9. If chosen, to whom would the members make their cheque payable to?
10. Why did you personally choose this charity? What is your connection to this charity?

\*Members are those women who have signed a "Commitment Form" and are in good standing with their donations.
